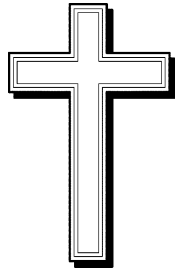

Sacramental Schedule

Reconciliation – Saturday prior to Mass in Phillipsburg, Sunday Morning prior to Mass in Logan; or contact the priest to set up an appointment for confession.
Baptism – contact the priest to schedule. Instructions required with the first child.
Marriage–contact the priest at least six months prior to the wedding date to complete required marriage preparation.

Anointing of the Sick – contact the priest to schedule a time to be anointed.
If you are admitted to the hospital, please ask the hospital or a family member to contact the priest so that he may come to visit you, or if you are homebound.

We are gifted with a Food from Heaven!

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Today we celebrate the feast of the Body and Blood of Christ. This feast invites us to reflect on the Holy Eucharist. The Eucharist is not merely a symbol, a reminder, or a sacred meal. Christ Himself, truly present among us and fulfills His promise "I am with you always, until the end of the age" (Mt 28:20).

In the 1st reading we heard that God fed the Israelites with manna from heaven. It was a sign of God's loving care. In our lives too, when we face temptations, disappointments, illnesses, loneliness, and struggles; just as God fed Israel, his son Jesus Christ feeds us with the true Bread from Heaven.

In the gospel Jesus makes a declaration: "I am the living bread that came down from heaven. Whoever eats this bread will live forever." "My flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink." He offers not something He possesses but who He is. He gives Himself entirely. At Mass, Christ becomes present on the altar and offers Himself to us as spiritual nourishment.

St. Paul teaches that we, though many, are one body. The Eucharist not only unites us with Christ; it also unites us with one another. When we receive the Body of Christ, we also become the Body of Christ. The Eucharist calls us to overcome divisions, prejudices, resentments, and selfishness. We cannot receive Christ at the altar and ignore Christ in our neighbor. The Eucharist demands that we become people of reconciliation, compassion, and service. As St. Augustine beautifully said if we receive the Body of Christ, we must become His living presence in the world.
