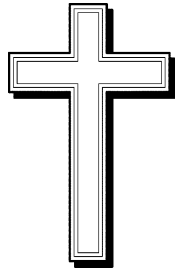

Sacramental Schedule

Reconciliation – Saturday prior to Mass in Phillipsburg, Sunday Morning prior to Mass in Logan; or contact the priest to set up an appointment for confession.
Baptism – contact the priest to schedule. Instructions required with the first child.
Marriage–contact the priest at least six months prior to the wedding date to complete required marriage preparation.

Anointing of the Sick – contact the priest to schedule a time to be anointed.
If you are admitted to the hospital, please ask the hospital or a family member to contact the priest so that he may come to visit you, or if you are homebound.

Do not Be Afraid

My dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Today's readings invite us to reflect on a message that is both comforting and challenging: "**Do not be afraid.**" Three times in the Gospel, Jesus tells His disciples not to fear. These words were spoken as He prepared them for the mission of proclaiming the Kingdom of God in a world that would not always welcome them.

The prophet Jeremiah experienced this reality firsthand. Because he faithfully spoke God's word, he faced ridicule, rejection, and persecution. Yet Jeremiah did not give up. St. Paul reminds us God's grace is greater than human weakness. God's love is stronger than sin. God's mercy triumphs over fear.

Many Christians today experience similar struggles. We may not face imprisonment or physical persecution, but we often encounter criticism, misunderstanding, or pressure to compromise our faith. In a society where Christian values are sometimes ignored or ridiculed, it can be tempting to remain silent. The Gospel is not meant to be hidden. Therefore, Christians are people of hope, not despair. Faith is a gift to be shared.

Let us ask the Lord to remove our fears and strengthen our trust in Him. May we have the courage of Jeremiah, the faith of St. Paul, and the confidence that comes from knowing that we are deeply loved by God. Then, whatever challenges we face, we can walk forward with hope, hearing Jesus say to us: "**Do not be afraid.**"
