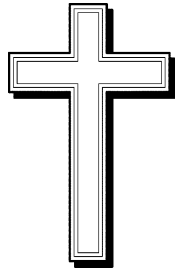

Sacramental Schedule

Reconciliation – Saturday prior to Mass in Phillipsburg, Sunday Morning prior to Mass in Logan; or contact the priest to set up an appointment for confession.
Baptism – contact the priest to schedule. Instructions required with the first child.
Marriage–contact the priest at least six months prior to the wedding date to complete required marriage preparation.

Anointing of the Sick – contact the priest to schedule a time to be anointed.
If you are admitted to the hospital, please ask the hospital or a family member to contact the priest so that he may come to visit you, or if you are homebound.

"Come to Me, and I Will Give You Rest"

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

We live in a world that is tired. People are exhausted physically, emotionally, mentally, and spiritually. Many carry burdens that no one else sees. Even children and young people experience stress and pressure. Amid all these struggles, Jesus says: **"Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest."** These words reveal the very heart of Jesus. He is the Good Shepherd who invites the weary to find peace in Him.

The prophet Zechariah announces the Messianic king who is *meek and riding on a donkey*. God's King comes with humility. His kingdom is built upon humility, forgiveness, and sacrificial love. Jesus teaches that true greatness is found in humility and service.

In the Gospel, Jesus draws our attention to Humility. Humility is the key that opens the door to God's wisdom. Many saints were highly educated, yet they remained humble before God. They knew that faith is not merely knowledge but a relationship of love and trust.

Come to me. Take my yoke upon you. If we are already carrying heavy burdens, why does Jesus ask us to take another yoke? Usually, an experienced ox was yoked together with a younger one. The stronger animal carried most of the weight while teaching the younger one. Jesus promises that we will never carry those burdens alone. He bears the greater part of the load and walk beside us. That is why His yoke is easy and His burden is light not because there is no burden, but because His love strengthens us.

As followers of Christ, we are called not to add burdens to others through criticism, anger, gossip, or indifference, but to help carry one another's crosses. Let us walk beside Him with humble hearts, allowing the Holy Spirit to guide our lives.
